



(a) Whether Government has appointed more employees on contractual basis than regular/permanent appointments since 2019 till date;	OIDB is a small organization having a sanctioned strength of 32 only. Against this, there are 15 posts filled on a permanent/ deputation basis, and the remaining vacancies are being filled up as per the OIDB recruitment regulations. However, the engagement of consultants against the regular vacancies has been kept bare minimum for the smooth functioning of the office work. Moreover, at present there is no contractual engagement against any regular vacancy. At present only two Consultants are engaged on a retainership basis (part-time) for specific purposes in the field of Legal & Chartered Accountant in OIDB.																					
b) If so, the reasons for the decline in regular/permanent appointments in Central Government;	As per the Oil Industry Development Board Employees (Recruitment) Regulations, the method of recruitment for most of the posts in OIDB, is prescribed as by promotion, failing which by deputation & direct recruitment. Despite efforts, sufficient applications from eligible candidates have not been received against the OIDB advertisement for filling up the vacancies on a deputation basis.



(a) Whether the Government has taken adequate steps to fill up the vacancies falling under the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas and all its PSUs, Allied offices and if so, the details thereof;	The adequate steps had been taken by OIDB to fill up the vacancies in OIDB as per its Recruitment Regulations by publishing the vacancies in the Employment News paper & other leading News papers.
b) If so the details thereof	OIDB had published vacancies in the Employment News paper & other leading News papers for filling up the thirteen vacant posts on deputation basis during 2023 & 2024. However, the insufficient responses have been received. Presently, the two candidates for the post of Section Officers & One candidate for the post of Steno Grade-B, have been selected by OIDB on deputation basis and the appointment letters have been issued to them. Efforts are being made by OIDB for filling up the other vacant posts.
(b) The incumbency position as on 01.07.2024 in respect of all Aided Institutes, all Public Sector Undertakings under aegis of the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas; and	The incumbency position as on 01.07.2024 in OIDB is Eleven posts.
(c) Whether the Government has initiated any special recruitment drive for filling up of vacancies in SC/ST/OBC and Minority communities and if so, the details thereof if not, the reasons there for?	OIDB is a small organization and the sanctioned strength in each category of post in OIDB is quite minimal. Therefore, there is no backlog vacancy of SC/ST/OBC Minority communities for direct recruitments in OIDB.
